

STATUTES
of
VARNA SCIENTIFIC AND TECHNICAL UNIONS

I. BASIC CONDITIONS

Core, objectives and location

Art.1 (1). The VARNA SCIENTIFIC AND TECHNICAL UNIONS is a professional, scientific, non-government, non political and non profit society constituted under the Law of legal non profit entities referred here in after as "the Society".

(2) The name of the Society is "Teritorialna organizaciya na nauchno-technicheskite sauzyi-Varna" with abbreviation "TO na NTS-Varna".

The name on English should be written as "Varna Scientific and Technical Unions", with abbreviation VSTU.

(3) The Society is constituted in the form of a "Private Non-Profit Organization". The main activities of the Society is in the field of technics , technologies, technical education and the related sciences.

Art.2. The Society has structural sections of his individual members (physical entities) based on professional, territorial, practical or other indication. Except individual members the society has also joint members (legal entities) such as universities, scientific institutes, companies and other institutions in the field of the sciences and technics.

Art.3. The Society represent the constituted structural sections and his members against other Bulgarian and foreign physical and legal entities.

Art.4 (1). The Society performs additional economics activities related to his main object and utilize all the incomes to reach the defined in this Statutes objective.

(2). The object of the additional economic activities is:

1. Vocational training courses.
2. Scientific-technical conferences.
3. Services in the field of information technologies, intellectual property and standardization.
4. Information and publishing activities.
5. Development and implementation of scientific, technical, economical and other projects.
6. Office services.
7. Rents for temporary usage of premises.
8. Advertisement activities.
9. Other activities related to the objectives of the Society.

(3). The additional economic activities are subordinated to the conditions and the rules provided in the normative documents and registration.

(4). The Society does not share out the profit. The income from the additional economic activities could be utilized only for fulfillment of the main objectives of the Society.

Art.5. The location of Society is in Varna, 25 , "Tcar Simeon I" str.

Art.6. The Society posses his trademark and stamp.

Art.7. The Society is not limited by term or other suspension clause.

Art.8. The main objectives of the Society are:

Objectives

1. To unite in an organizational aspect, to represent and protect the creative, professional and social interests of its members;
2. To establish conditions for providing information support and enhancing the professional qualification of its members;
3. To assist its members in the implementation of their scientific and technical achievements in practice;
4. To establish relations and cooperation with similar Bulgarian, foreign and international organizations for holding joint scientific and technical events and undertaking joint research and development.

Means

Art. 9. These objectives shall be accomplished by the following means:

1. Independently or together with other similar organizations, to organize and hold regional, national and international scientific and technical conferences, symposia, discussions, etc.;
2. Independently or together with other similar organizations, to prepare and distribute printed, audio and video-information in the field of the Association's scope of activities;
3. At preferential prices, to provide its members with internet access, computer services and enquires about standards;
4. To organize and undertake training for enhancing the qualification of engineers and other specialists;
5. To collect and keep information about specialists and research in the country and abroad, which may be of interest to the members of the Association;
6. Independently or together with other similar organizations, to carry out contracted research development, expert's evaluations and opinions, etc., by attracting specialists among its members for the accomplishment of any such tasks;
7. To undertake cooperation with other organizations for the purpose of protecting the intellectual property, the creative and professional interests of its members and for solving other issues of common interest;
8. To provide material support to its members, if necessary, in case of illness;
9. To decide on symbolic and material awards and incentives for engineers, specialists and students;
10. To support the participation of its members in scientific and technical events.
11. To maintain and develop the material and technical facilities of the Association.
